It stands for Educational, Health, Care, Plan. Bit of a mouthful so it is shortened to EHCP!

It is a legally binding document that supports you in school and can support you up until you are 25.

It will have everything in the document what you would need day to day and what outcomes you would like to achieve.

Why you might need an EHCP?

You may have a special educational need such as Autism, a disability, social care need or a health need.

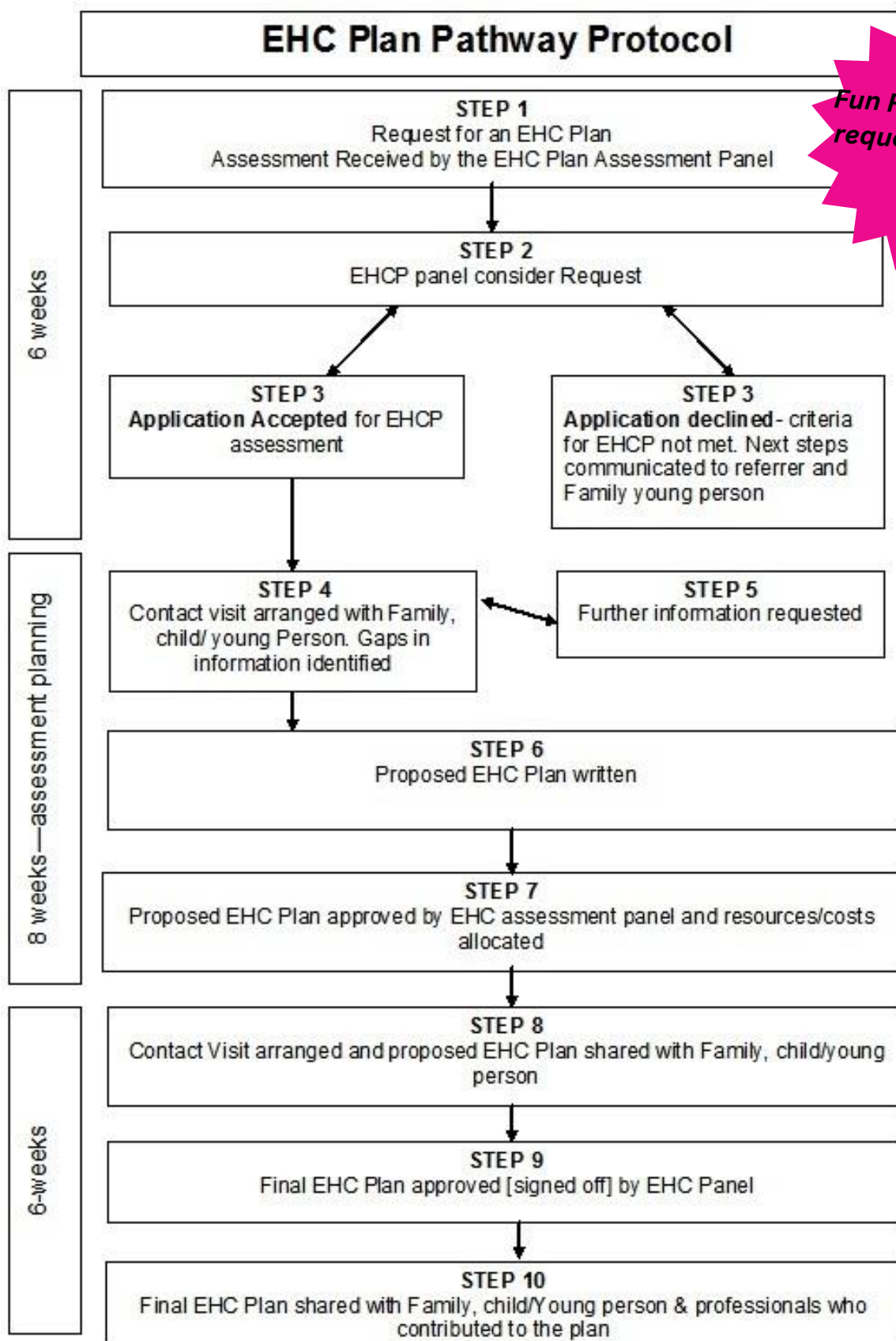
So therefore, Your parent/carer or school or another professional may have identified that you may need some additional support within school.
